

PORTRAITS OF PRESERVATION AUCTION & GALA

Thank you to all of the Utah Open Lands supporters who generously gave during the Portraits of Preservation Auction and Gala! Your contributions are helping us protect and preserve Utah's precious landscapes for generations to come and your dedication to conservation is nothing short of inspiring! The Portraits of Preservation Gala, which took place earlier this month at the River Bottoms Ranch, was filled with warmth, community, and celebration. It allowed us to come together, reconnect, and share the remarkable conservation successes that organization has achieved since our last gathering. Member support has been the driving force behind these accomplishments, and your dedication to our cause continues to motivate us. At the gala, UOL Executive Director, Wendy Fisher, highlighted the

landowners who just in the last 18 months donated conservation easements. Among these donations was the increased conservation around the Galena Soo'nkahni Preserve where UOL worked to safeguard lands which are consider sacred as ancestral by seven tribes of Utah. She summed everything up by saying. "I think we are even more in need of the real, of sanctuary that provides true relief, of authentic discussion about our survival and I think the stage is the lands we protect, the lands that feed our tomorrow and hold the inspiration of our past. As digital platforms vy for our focus, it is the connectedness of our footprints on the ground, the tangible real landscapes we save that will continue to capture our imagination, sustain our sense of who we are and where we are from. These landscapes will forever bring us home."


LAST WEEKEND OF TRANSIT TO TRAILS

On this day, 30 dedicated AAC volunteers will join forces with Utah Open Lands, Grand County Trail Crew and Trail Ambassador (GCATT), Leave No Trace, and Friends of Indian Creek. Together, we'll tackle an essential task — rebuilding tent platforms at the campground.

This not only enhances camper safety and comfort but also helps deter dispersed camping, which is not permitted at Castleton Tower due to its ecological sensitivity.
